BY-LAW 2306

Being a By-law to Amend Public Notice By-law 972

WHEREAS Council deems it to be in the public interest;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT The Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Central Elgin enacts as follows:

- 1. "Schedule A" to By-law 972 is hereby repealed, and the attached "Schedule A" to this By-law is substituted therefor;
- 2. Section 1 By-law 972 shall be amended by adding thereto:
 - j) "Social Media" means websites and applications, used in an official capacity by The Corporation of the Municipality of Central Elgin, that enable users to create and share content; and
 - k) "Website" means the Corporation of the Municipality of Central Elgin official website at www.centralelgin.org.
- 3. A copy of the said Agreement shall remain attached to and form part of this By-law.

Shut-off of Public Utility	81	least seven (7) days prior to shut-off
Proposal to Restructure	173	Notice of public meeting published once in at least one newspaper in the opinion of the Clerk that is of sufficiently general circulation in the area to which the proposed by-law would apply to give the public reasonable notice at least twenty-one (21) days prior to public meeting Municipal website and social media accounts

Establish, Change Ward Boundaries or Dissolving Existing Wards	222	Notice of public meeting published once in at least one newspaper in the opinion of the Clerk that is of sufficiently general circulation in the area to which the proposed by-law would apply to give the public reasonable notice at least twenty-one (21) days prior to public meeting Municipal website and social media accounts
Adoption of Budget	291	Notice of intention to pass a by-law published once in at least one newspaper in the opinion of the Clerk that is of sufficiently general circulation in the area to which the proposed by-law would apply to give the public reasonable notice at least ten (10) days prior to the Council meeting when the by-law is to be considered Municipal website and social media accounts
Seizure of Land	351	The treasurer or the treasurer's agent shall give the public twenty-one (21) days notice of the time and place of the public auction and of the name of the person whose personal property is to be sold.
Fees and charges Sewer, Water	400	Notice of intention to pass a by-law by one of the following methods, as determined by the Clerk, at least eleven (11) days prior to the Council meeting when the proposed by-law is to be considered: Published once in at least one newspaper in the opinion of the Clerk that is of sufficiently general circulation in the area to which the proposed by-law would apply to give the public reasonable notice; or Posted on the Municipal website and social media accounts; or Mailed to property owners, as shown on assessment roll, to which the proposed by-law will apply
Alter Time of Regular Meeting	By-law 2307	Notice of alteration shall be posted on the Municipal website and social media accounts at least ten (10) days prior to the time when the Regular Council meeting is to be held
