Being a By-law to Amend By-law 465

WHEREAS Council enacted By-law 465, Being a By-law respecting the designation and control of potentially dangerous and dangerous dogs, on June 24, 2002;

AND WHEREAS Council wishes to amend said By-law;


NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Central Elgin enacts as follows,

1. Section 4.1 of By-law 465 is hereby repealed and the following section substituted therefor:

4.1 Every person who contravenes any provision of this By-law, including but not limited to the failure to comply with any notice issued by the Canine Control Officer, is guilty of an offence and upon conviction is liable to a fine as provided in the Provincial Offences Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.33, as amended or any successor legislation thereto.

READ a THIRD TIME and FINALLY PASSED this 27th day of January, 2003.
