

## Municipality of Central Elgin Mayoral Decision MDE-2025-10

Decision to give written approval of By-laws passed at the December 8, 2025 Council Meeting

Mayoral decision under Bill 3, the Strong Mayors, Building Homes Act, 2022, which amended the Municipal Act, 2001. I, Andrew Sloan, Mayor of the Municipality of Central Elgin, hereby give written approval of the following By-laws passed at the Council Meeting of December 8, 2025, in accordance with subsection 284.11(4)(a)(i) of the Municipal Act, 2001:

- By-law 2025-058, being a By-law to assume ownership of Phase 2 works Kokomo Subdivision
- By-law 2025-059, being a By-law to establish rates to recover part of the capital cost of the extension of sanitary sewage works on Hill Street, west of Beamish Street
- By-law 2025-060, being a By-law to provide for a drainage works in the Municipality of Central Elgin in the County of Elgin (First Reading)
- By-law 2025-061, being a By-law to provide for a 2026 interim tax levy for all taxation classes and to provide for the payment of taxes, penalty, and interest charges of 1.25 percent per month
- By-law 2025-062, being a By-law to authorize the use of vote-counting equipment such as optical scanning vote tabulators for the 2026 Municipal and School Board Election
