## Mayoral Decision MDE-2026-03

### Decision to give written approval of By-laws passed at the February 9, 2026 Council Meeting

Mayoral decision under Bill 3, the Strong Mayors, Building Homes Act, 2022, which amended the Municipal Act, 2001. I, Andrew Sloan, Mayor of the Municipality of Central Elgin, hereby give written approval of the following By-laws passed at the Council Meeting of January 26, 2026, in accordance with subsection 284.11(4)(a)(i) of the Municipal Act, 2001:

- By-law 2026-07, being a by-law to Amend Village of Port Stanley Zoning By-law No. 1507
- By-law 2026-08, being a by-law to Amend Township of Yarmouth Zoning By-law No. 1998
- By-law 2026-09, being a by-law to Impose Water and Wastewater User Fees
- By-law 2026-010, being a by-law to Levy a Special Charge upon the Rateable Property in the Port Stanley Business Improvement Area for the Year 2026
- By-law 2026-011, being a by-law to designate a Property known Municipally as 7435 Quaker Road to be of Cultural Heritage Value or Interest
- By-law 2026-012, being a by-law to establish an Election Joint Compliance Audit Committee for the 2026 Municipal Election in accordance with the Municipal Elections Act, 1996, as amended.
- By-law 2026-013, being a by-law to establish levies for the year 2026, adopt tax rates, provide for penalty and interest in default of payment, and the collection thereof
- By-law 2026-014, being a by-law to authorize temporary borrowing for current or capital expenditures during the fiscal year ending December 31, 2026
- By-law 2026-016, being a by-law to amend the appointees to the Port Stanley BIA Board of Management for the 2022-2026 term of Council
