We place a high value on improving our lines of communication to our communities. We want our residents to be able to connect to and access whatever interests them. We hope you like these platforms as much as we do!



## **Interim Property Tax**

FINANCIAL SERVICES

The 2022 interim property tax bills are calculated by taking 50% of your 2021 property taxes levied. The 2022 final property tax bills will be issued in July and will reflect the 2022 property taxes levied, less the 2022 interim billing.



## **Dog Tags**

BY LAW ENFORCEMENT

Residents are no longer required to purchase a dog tag from the Municipality. The requirement of pet owners to identify their dog will now be their responsibility. Each owner is to obtain their own tag or microchip, with owner contact information. The identification tag must include a phone number for the owner of the dog.
