PERMIT IS VALID FOR THREE (3) WEEKS AND ONLY FOR THE DATES SPECIFIED.

In accordance with the Ontario Fire Code Ontario Regulation 388/97 Subsection 2.6.3.4.

Requirements:

1. Pile must be kept small while burning.
2. Fire must be supervised at all times.
3. Burning is limited to between daylight and dusk. Fire must be extinguished by dark.
4. Burning is limited to the location listed on permit.
5. Weather conditions must be favourable for burning to be permitted.
6. Fire Dispatch must be notified prior to starting.
7. Extinguishing equipment must be at fire location.
8. Advise your neighbours – complaints may terminate the permit.
9. Any contraventions will terminate the permit – Fee for service min \$500.

It is the understanding of the municipality that the bearer of the permit is solely liable for any or all damage resulting from open burning.
