### Mini Tower Cellular Project

Council has directed staff to negotiate an agreement with Shared Tower for the construction of five mini towers. These towers will be installed on sites owned by the Municipality, Erie Rest Beach, Main Beach, East Headland, Lion's Landing Marina, and Port Stanley Arena. The mini towers will help improve the cellular coverage for the 5G network, providing more reliable and efficient data transmission for customers in the area. Council believes that this partnership with Shared Tower will benefit the community by providing better cellular services and increasing the overall connectivity in the municipality.

#### Council Takes Action to

### **Diversify Assessment Base**

Council passed a resolution to prioritize affordability by diversifying the assessment base. The employment lands listed in **Schedule K of the Municipality of Central Elgin's Official Plan** are considered highly valuable for economic development in the Province of Ontario. The Council has instructed staff to hire MHBC Planning, Urban Design, and Landscape Architecture to complete a zoning by-law for the employment lands, to prepare the lands for economic development.
