2022 Belmont Santa Claus Parade

Council approved the Special Events Permit for the 2022 Belmont Santa Claus Parade, which will be held on Sunday, December 4th at 6pm.

Organizers will have the parade start from Belmont Farm Supply proceeding north along Belmont Road and ending at Washburn.

2022 Paid Parking

Status Report

Council received the 2022 Paid Parking Program Status Report.

The Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Central Elgin Strategic Plan included strategic priorities pertaining to adequate, sustainable and affordable infrastructure as follows:

- Develop and adopt a long-term plan for capital expenditures and financing
- Identify and pursue non-tax funding sources

Paid parking operates daily 10am - 5pm between May 1 - September 30 annually. The boat launch lot operates 24 hours/day between May 1 - September 30 annually. The 2022 Paid Parking Program is projected to provide \$519,694 of net, non-tax revenues to be utilized to fund future capital projects or initiatives as determined by Council.
