



**NOTICE OF DECISION REGARDING THE APPEAL OF A POTENTIALLY DANGEROUS  
DOG DESIGNATION**

**TAKE NOTICE** that an appeal was filed by Erika Cheeseman regarding a Potentially Dangerous Dog Designation by the Municipal Law Enforcement Officer of Moose, a Dane-Mastiff, pursuant to Municipality of Central Elgin By-law No. 0456.

**AND THAT** the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Central Elgin held a hybrid hearing on Monday, January 9, 2023 to consider such appeal respecting the designation of such dog as potentially dangerous.

**AND THAT** on Monday, January 9, 2023, the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Central Elgin confirmed the Potentially Dangerous Dog Designation of Moose, a Dane-Mastiff, pursuant to Municipality of Central Elgin By-law No. 0456. The Potentially Dangerous Dog Designation of December 13, 2022, and all conditions within the same is in full force and effect.
